

Wine List

Caposaldo Moscato – Lombardy, Italy **8g/30b**
Sweet, light, and effervescent, this wine delivers fragrant aromas of Acacia blossoms, peaches, and apricots with a crisp clean finish.

Saddlerock Orange Muscat -- Santa Barbara, California **9g/35b**
Hints of orange blossom are followed by fragrant flavors of nectarine with a honeyed finish, and a touch of spice. Slightly sweet, it can be enjoyed as an aperitif, with spicy dishes, and light desserts.

Charles Smith “Kung Fu Girl” Riesling – Columbia Valley, Washington **8g/30b**
Kung Fu Girl is bursting with Asian pear, white peach and spring flowers. Apricot, pear, lime, and a pleasant minerality keep this off-dry wine at the perfect level of subtle sweetness.

Loosen Brother’s Riesling -- Mosel Valley, Germany **8g/30b**
Lime and slate on the nose, palate of lime juice, peach juice, and slate create just a touch of sweetness and good acidity for this exceptional German Riesling.

MAN Vintner’s Chenin Blanc – Coastal Region, South Africa **7g/24b**
This wine has a uniquely delicious and tangy character that goes well with food and makes for an excellent aperitif with lively aromas of tropical fruits, melon, and crisp, bold citrus.

CC Chardonnay--Monterey, California **9g/35b**
This wine is full of fresh, unbridled fruit. It is produced entirely in stainless steel, which allows the green apple, melon and citrus flavors to shine through on the palate, followed by a refreshing finish.

Baroncini Pinot Grigio – Venetie, Italy **6g/22b**
The nose is intense with notes of pastoral flowers. It has a very fresh taste on the palate with little acidity, and ends with a bit of minerals and a hint of spring harvest.

Red Door Pinot Noir – Willamette Valley, Oregon **8g/29b**
Layered aromas of cigar box and wild cherry marry with earthy notes. A structured palate continues with cherry and cranberry, and finishes beautifully with lingering fruit and oak.

Saddlerock Pinot Noir – Central Coast, California **9g/35b**
A delicate balance of tea leaf and clove is complimented by notes of cherry, spice, and currant. The easy drinking tannins allow this wine to be enjoyed alone or with a variety of meals.

Ruta 22 Malbec – Neuquén, Argentina **7g/24b**
This wine is intense red violet in color, with characters of red fruit, and a hint of cassis on the nose. The palate is fruity with fresh acidity and firm tannins.

Artezin Zinfandel – Mendocino, California **9g/35b**
Ruby red and purple in hue, this wine has aromas of black pepper, boysenberry, clove, cinnamon and allspice. The red fruit flavors fill the palate, dominated by raspberry, red cherry and pomegranate.

Mont Gras Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon – Colchagua Valley, Chile **8g/33b**
The nose is complex with aromas of black cherry, currants, mocha, vanilla and cedar. The aromas carry through to the palate framed by toast and mocha from the infused oak.

Zeepard Shiraz – Western Australia **7g/26b**
Deep ruby red, the wine has ripe berry flavors with hints of spice. The subtle oak balances perfectly with the fruit providing a finish that is dry and persistent.

Cellar Reserve

Saddlerock Blanc de Blanc N/V – North Coast, California 64b

Produced from 100% Chardonnay grapes, it is pale straw in color with steady columns of tiny bubbles. Light in body, its crisp and inviting nose offers fresh exotic aromatics with a slight floral hint. The wine is delicate, with a touch of citrus and minerality.

Far Niente 2009 Chardonnay – Napa Valley, California 95b

The 2009 Far Niente Chardonnay offers aromas of Meyer lemon, honeysuckle and melon layered with toasted hazelnut and nutmeg. The entry is oily, long and silky with clean, bright acidity and fresh, tropical fruit flavors supported by sweet toasted oak.

Stag's Leap Cellars 2006 Merlot – Napa Valley, California 85b

This wine is wonderfully aromatic with intense fruit notes of cherry, pomegranate, plum and strawberry, laced with spicy accents of vanilla, white pepper, and cinnamon. The aromas carry over to the palate, with an additional touch of milk chocolate. Subtle tannins gently grip the palate of this gracefully structured wine.

Archery Summit 2007 Premier Cuvée – Willamette Valley, Oregon 85b

This wine opens with perfumed aromas of black cherry and raspberry, spicy plum and violets. On the palate, blueberry, plum, cassis and earthy notes converge around a fresh core of bright acidity and plush tannin lending this wine structure, vitality and grace. There is precision in the expression of fruit and an elegant yet ample succulent structure that progresses to a finish that is long and lasting with hints of blueberries, spiced cherries, exotic incense and fresh rose petals.

Semler Library Reserve 2002 Cabernet Sauvignon – Saddlerock-Malibu, California 75b

Inspired by the style of St. Estephe, this complex selection boasts an earthy nose layered with raspberry and the distinctive undercurrent of cedar, spice and tobacco. With its velvet texture and well-integrated tannins, this is an approachable pour with a sensual mouth feel.

Semler 2009 Ice Viognier – Saddlerock-Malibu, California 52b

The first ever Malibu Ice wine, this Semler Dessert wine contains late harvest Viognier and Sauvignon Blanc grapes from the Semler estate in the Saddle Rock-Malibu AVA that were flash frozen for 10 days and then slow pressed for over 20 hours. This wine has a nose of candied pecan and brioche with core flavors of apricot and wild honey on the palate.
